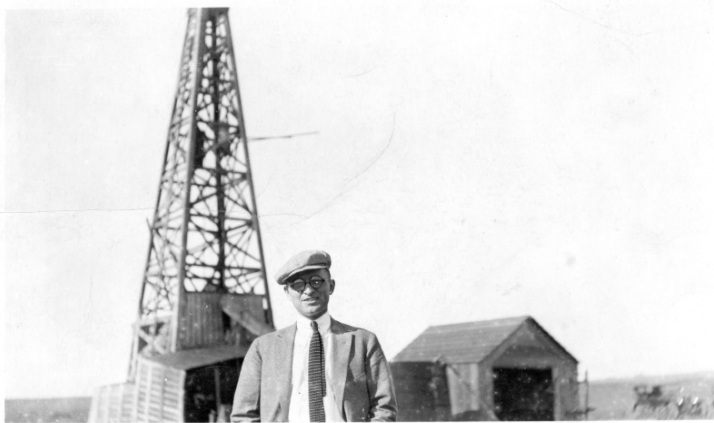


Truman in front of an oil well
