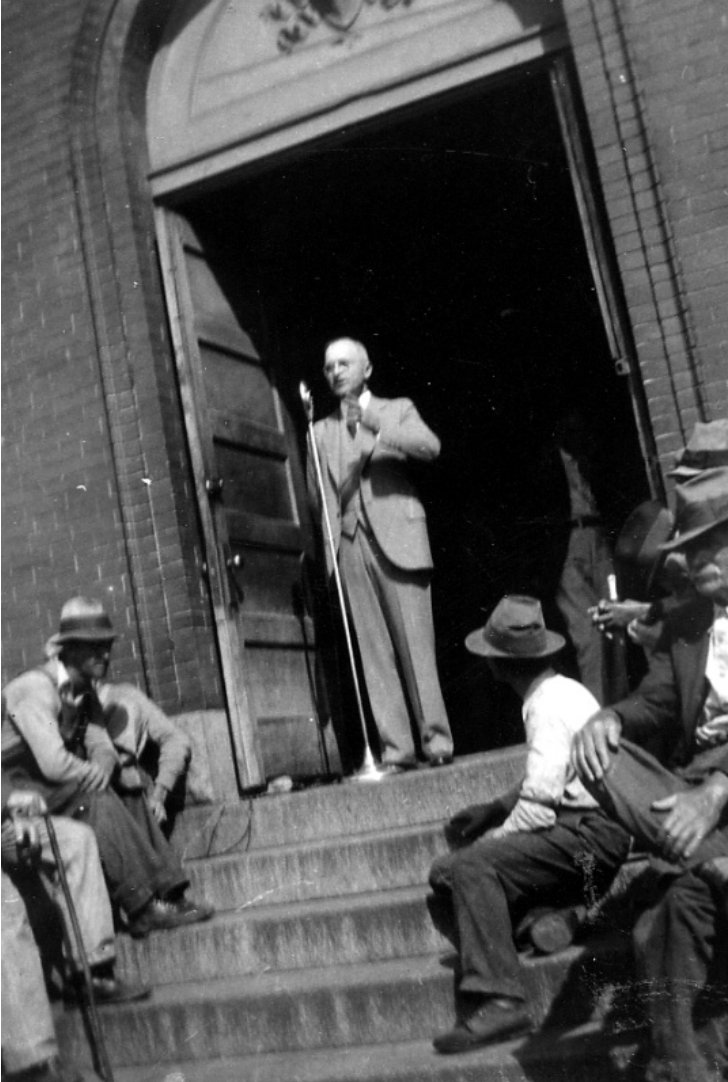


Harry S. Truman Senate Campaign - speech in Fredericktown
