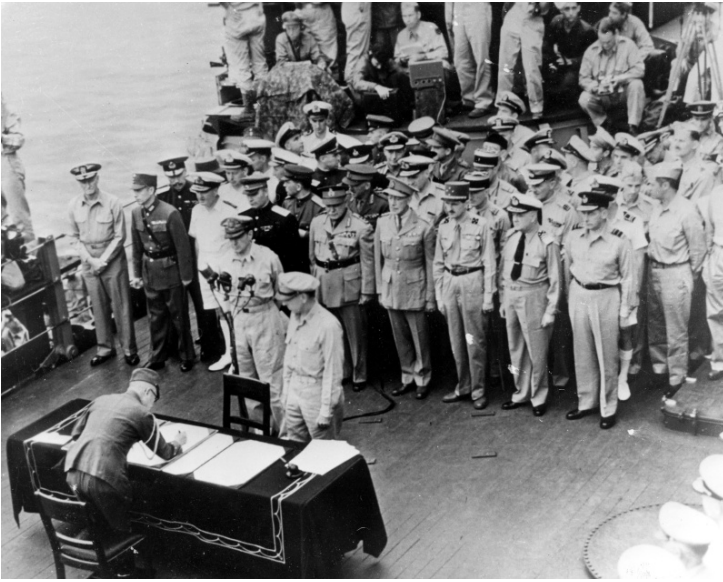


Japan surrenders on the U.S.S. Missouri
