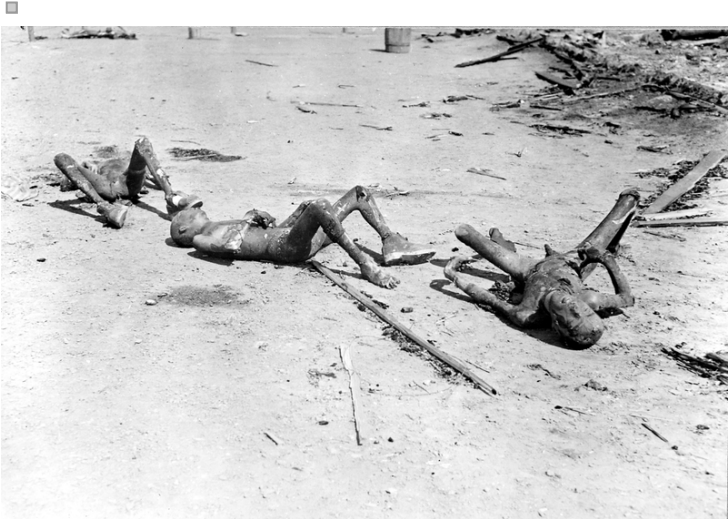


# Concentration camp victims near Leipzig
