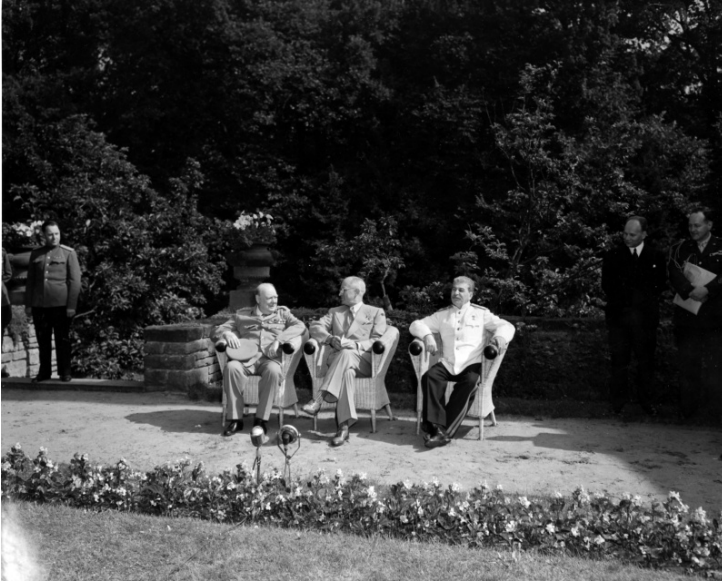


# President Truman, Prime Minister Churchill, and Generalissimo Stalin
