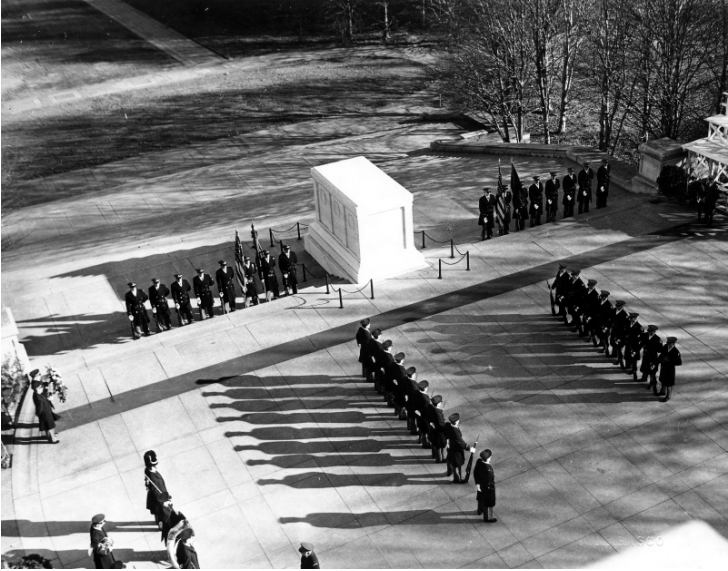


Wreath-laying ceremony in Arlington National Cemetery
