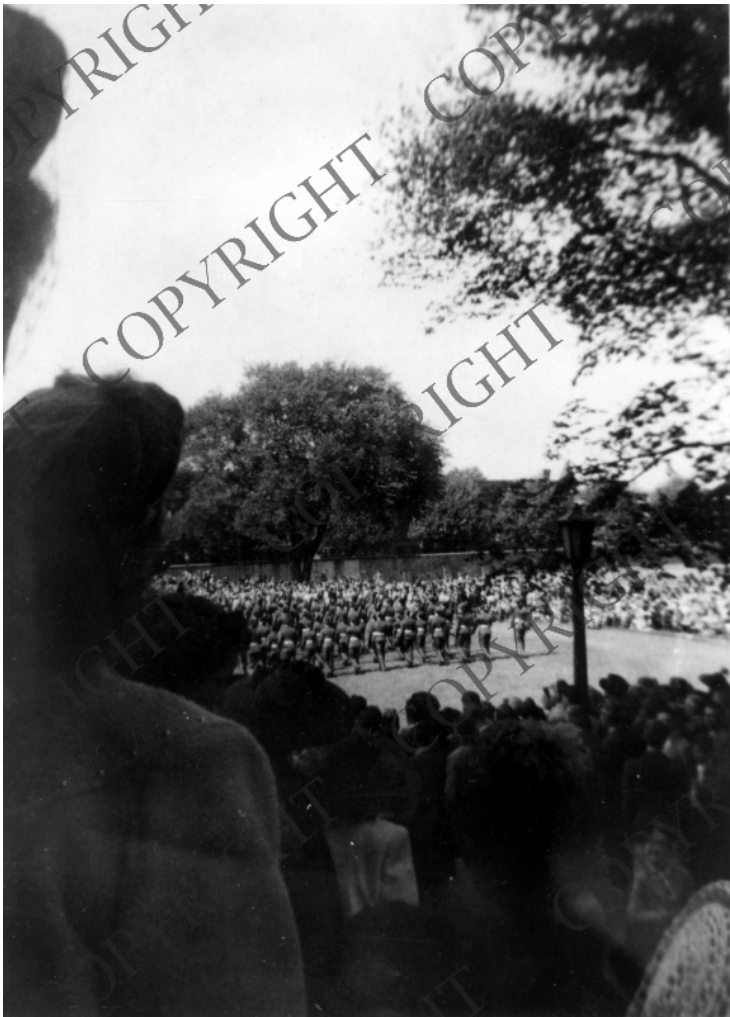


Military unit marches at Girard College, Pennsylvania
