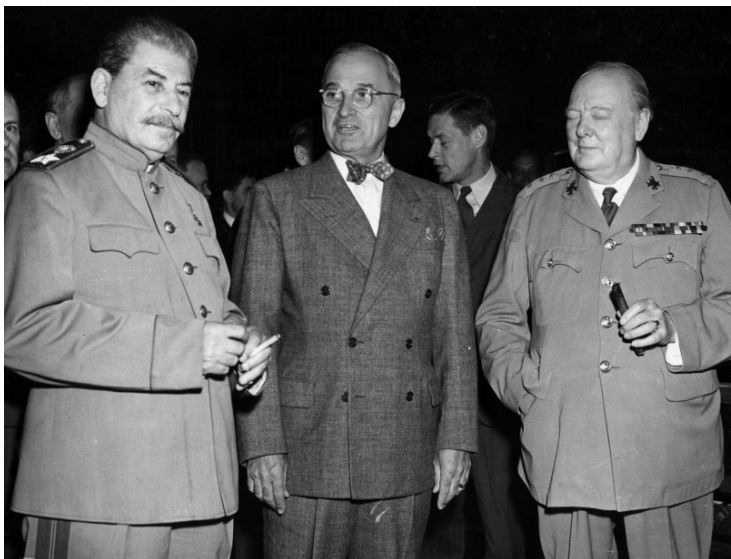


Stalin, Truman, and Churchill together for the first time
