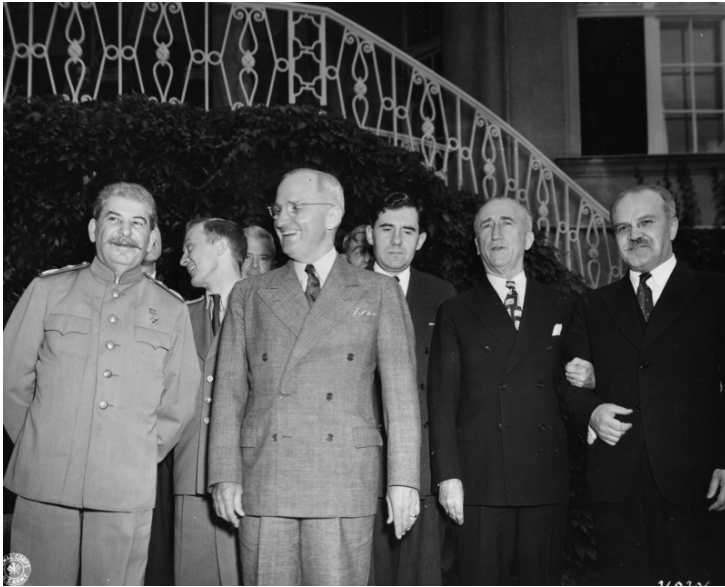


Stalin, Truman, Byrnes and Molotov during Potsdam Conference
