

INSTRUMENT OF GIFT

I, _____, give to the United States of America, for inclusion in the collections of the Library of Congress and for administration therein by the authorities thereof, the collection of my papers delivered to the Library of Congress _____, 19____, subject to the following conditions:

1. I hereby dedicate to the public my literary rights in these papers, or in other collections of my papers in the custody of the Library of Congress, except that these literary rights shall be reserved to me for a period of ten years from this date, or during my lifetime, whichever period is shorter.
2. That these papers shall be available to myself, and to members of the Manuscripts Division staff for processing purposes, but shall be available to others for the aforementioned period only by my written permission.

And further, subject to the aforementioned conditions I reserve the right to add thereto any of my additional papers that I may send to the Library of Congress in the future.
