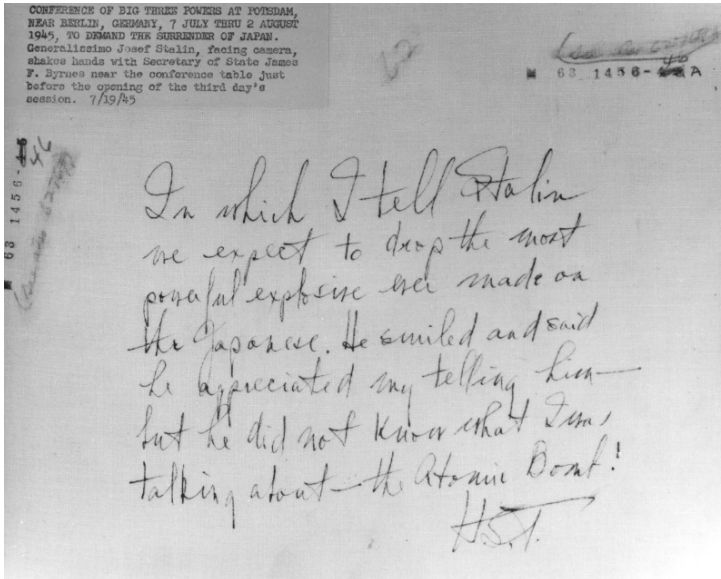


Truman's handwriting on the back of a Potsdam photograph describing telling Stalin about the atomic bomb

Harry S. Truman's handwriting on the back of a photograph of the Potsdam Conference area, accession number 63-1456-46: "In which I tell Stalin we expect to drop the most powerful explosive ever made on the Japanese.
