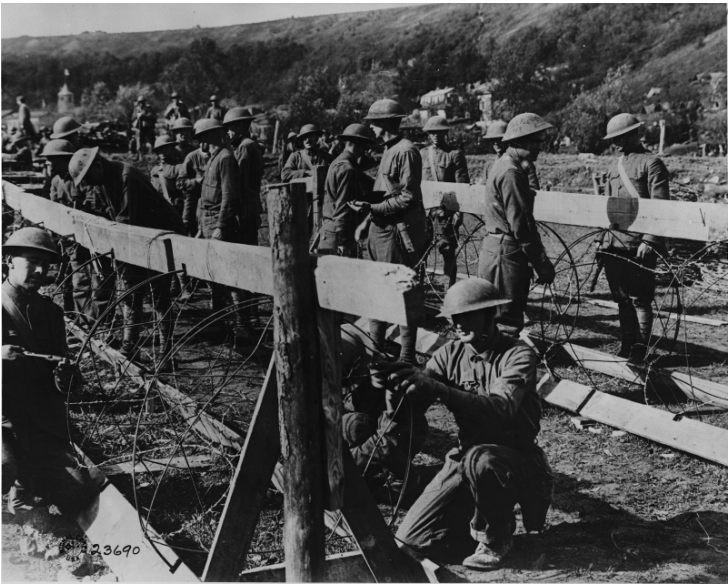


American engineers during World War I
