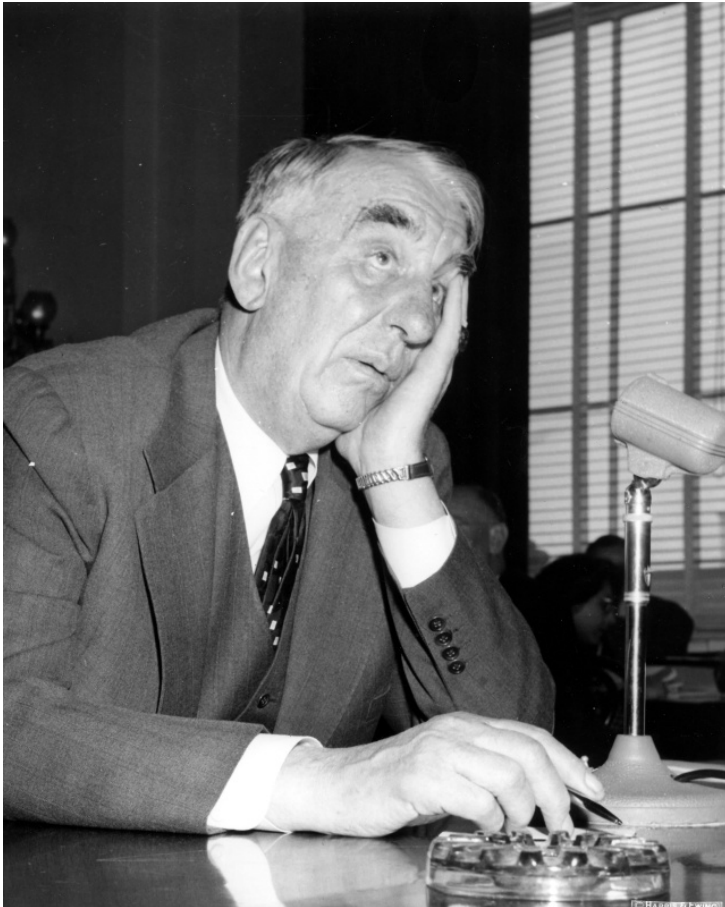


Photo of Conciliation Chief Cyrus S. Ching Testifying Before the Joint Congressional Committee on Atomic Energy
