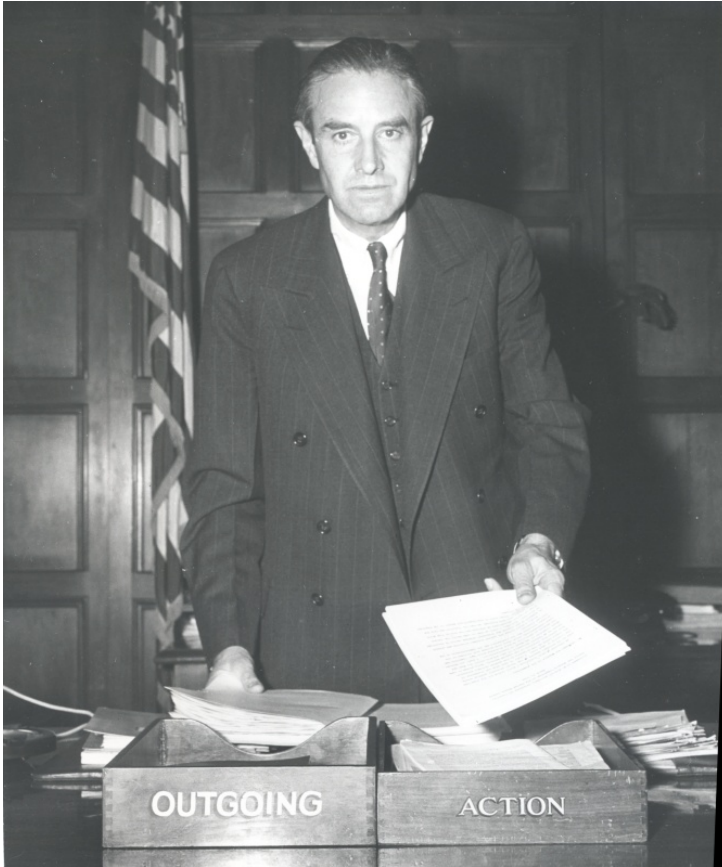


W. Averill Harriman, newly appointed Ambassador-at-large to the Marshall Plan countries
