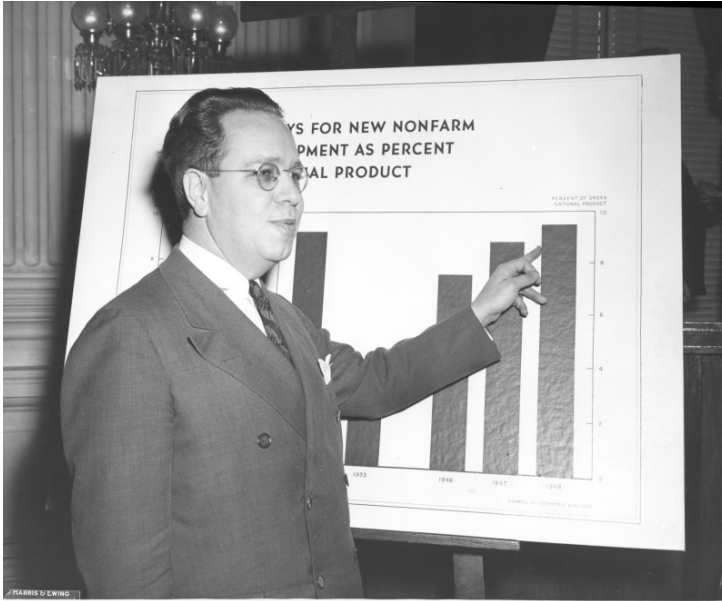


Photo of Leon H. Keyserling, Vice Chairman of President Truman's Council of Economic Advisers
