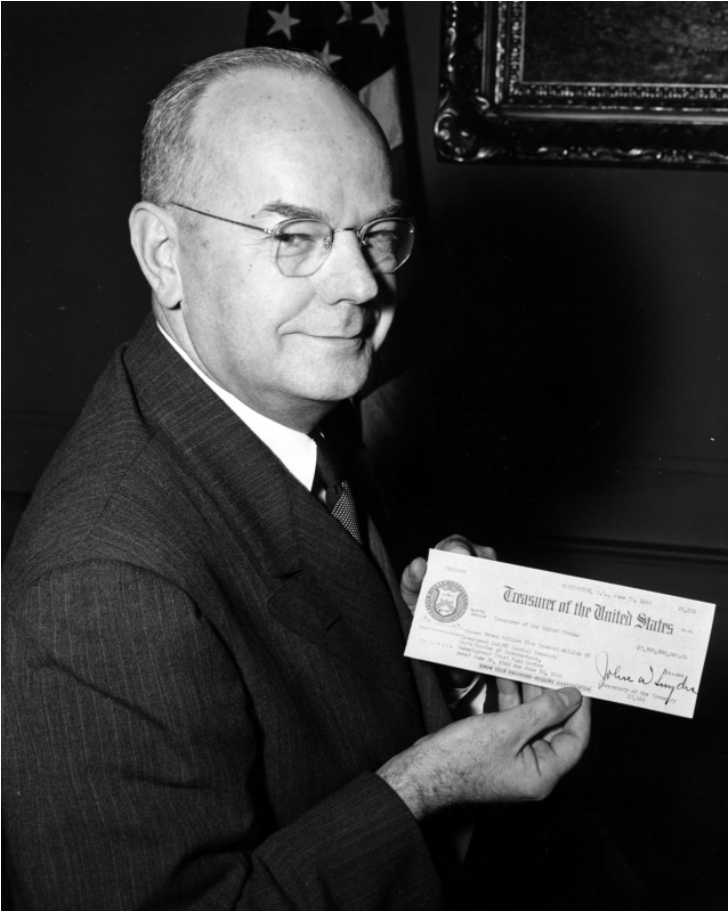


# Secretary of Treasury John W. Snyder after he put his signature on a check for \$7,500,000,000
