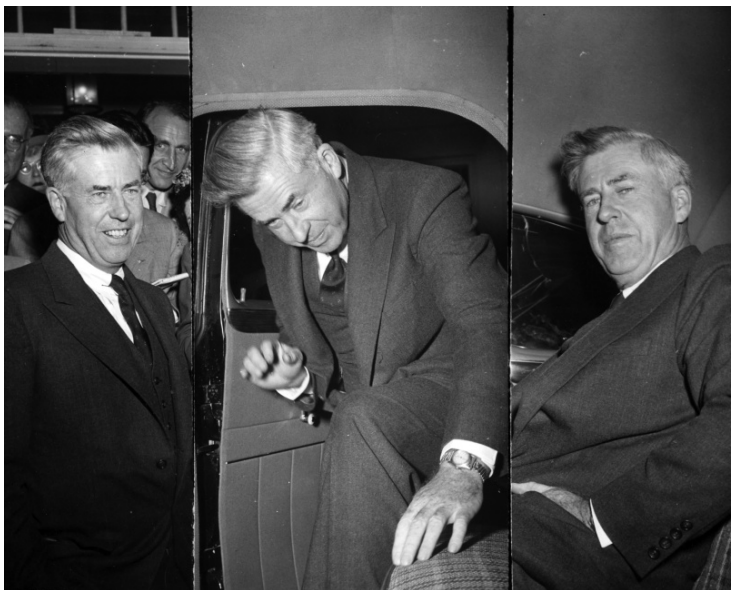


# Secretary of Commerce Henry A. Wallace
