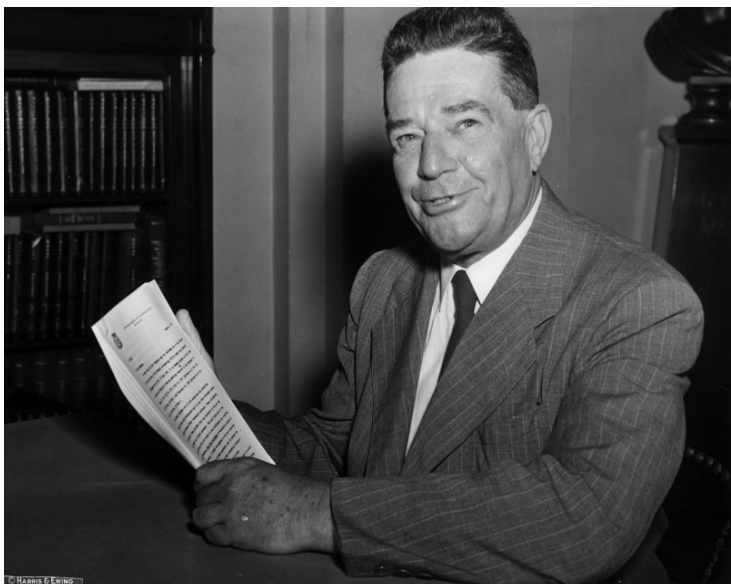


Comptroller General Lindsay C. Warren
