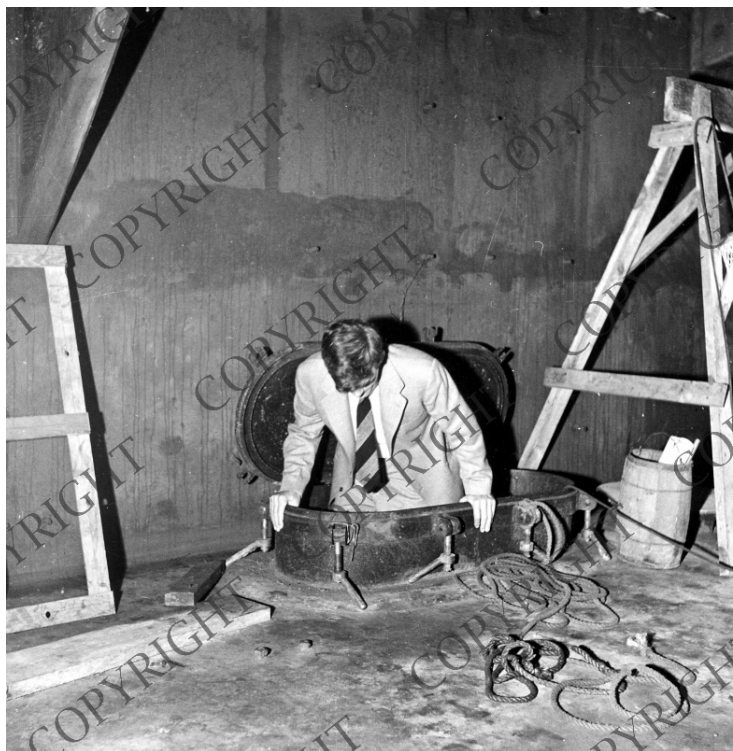


Senator Ball investigates a Navy vessel
