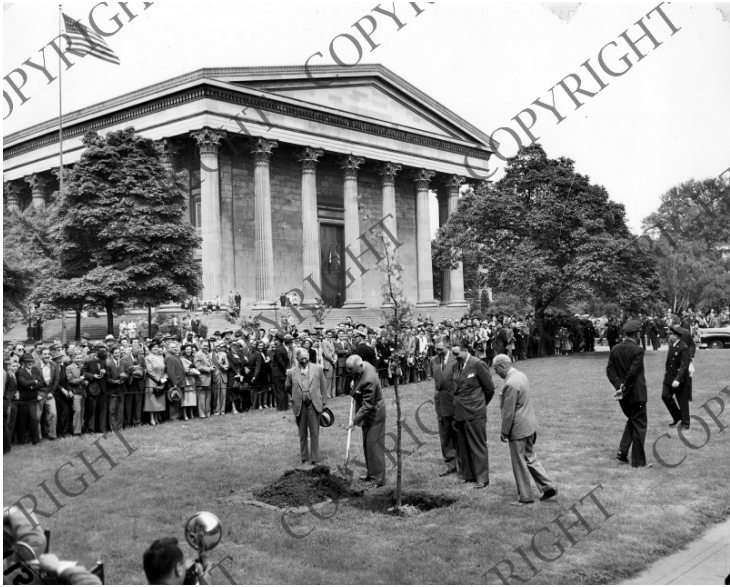


Truman plants tree before a crowd on the grounds of Girard College
