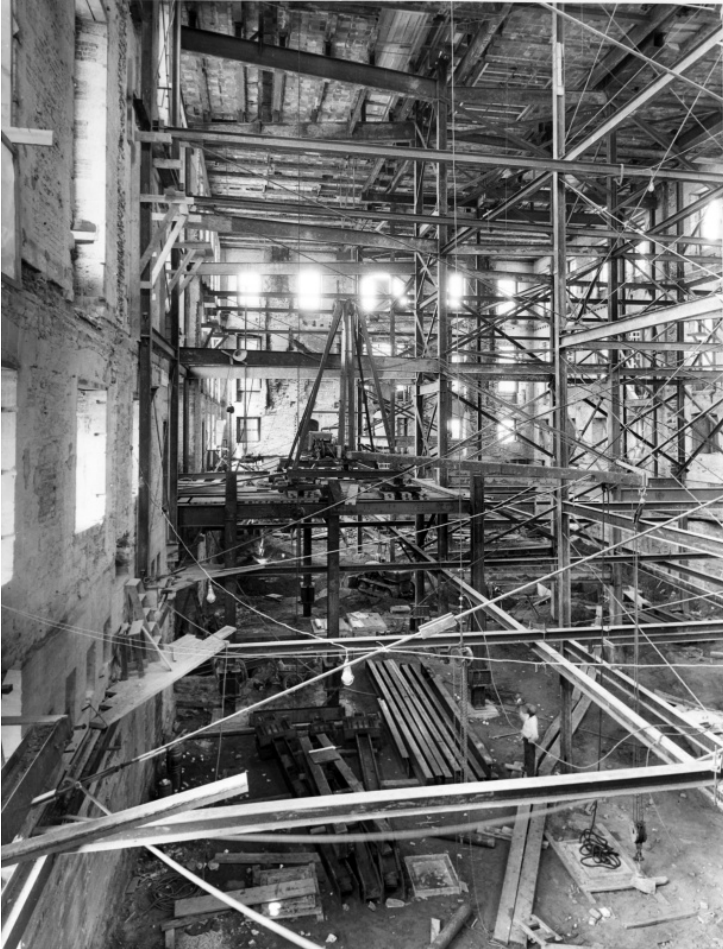


View from window of Room G-3 looking west during renovation of White House
