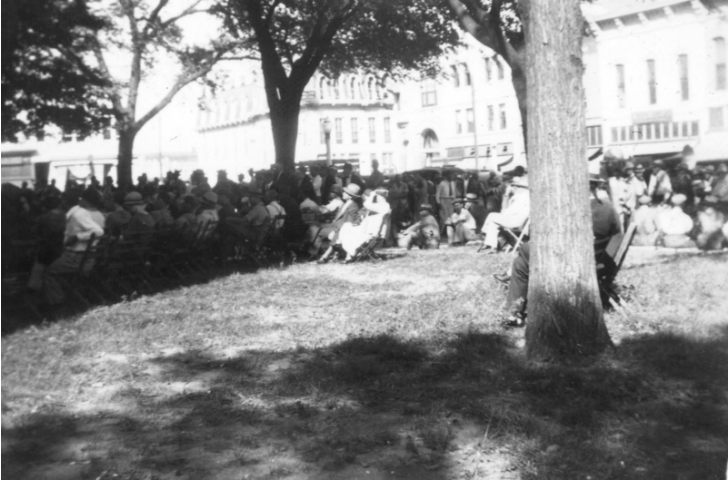


Large crowd in Carthage, Missouri during Truman's 1934 senatorial campaign
