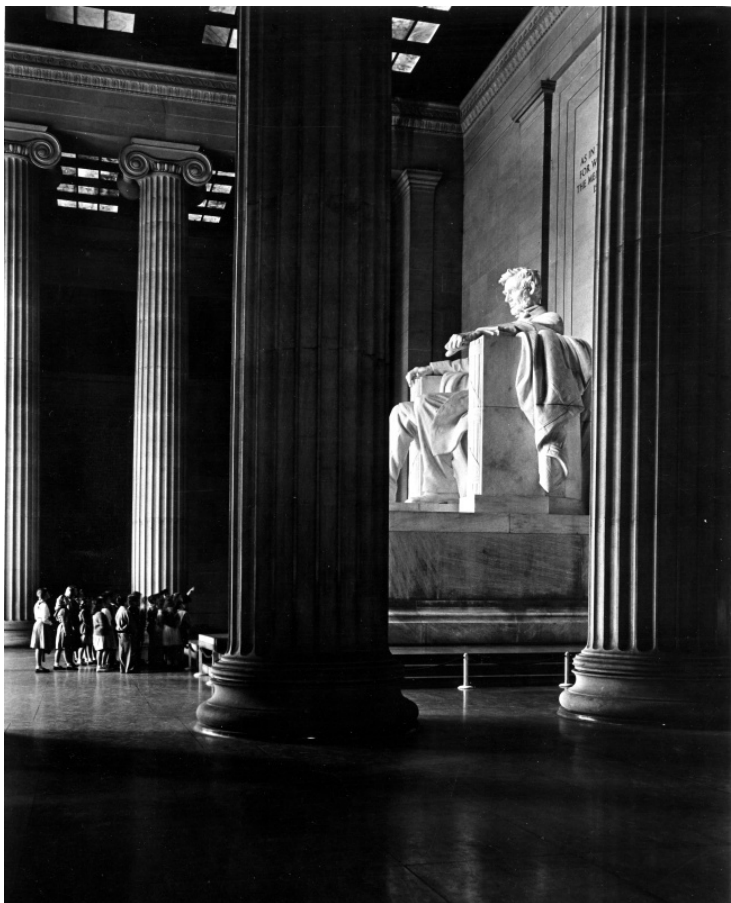


Statue of Abraham Lincoln
