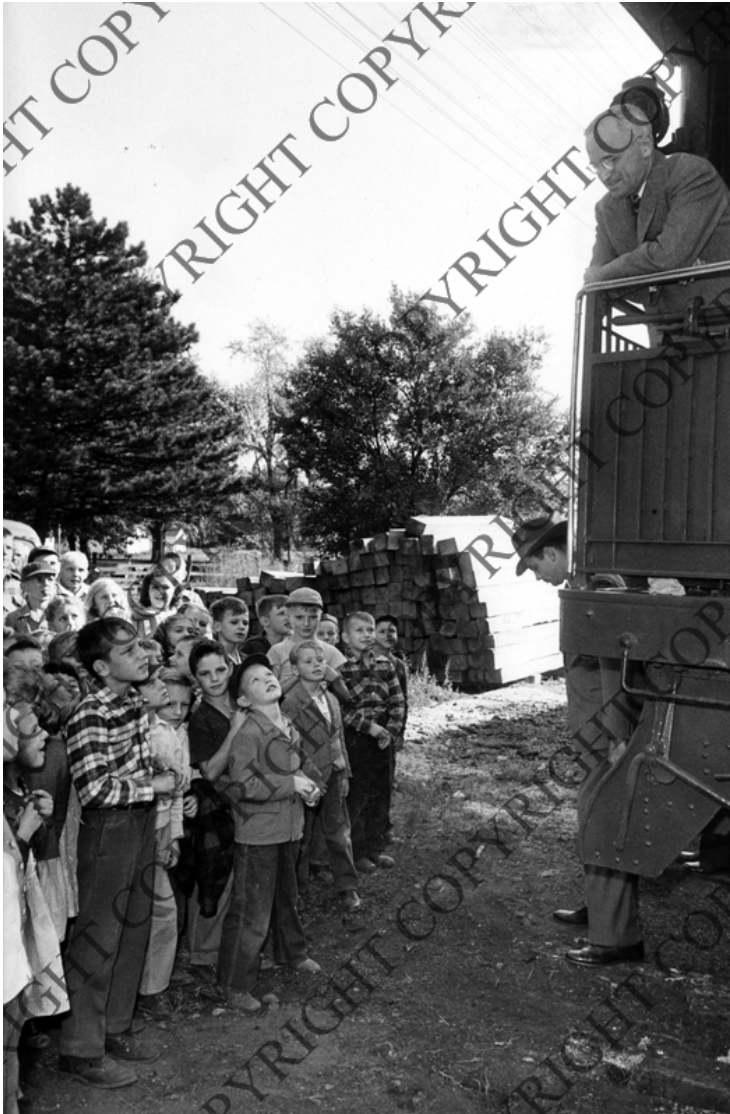


President Truman Greet Local Children While His Train is Stopped
