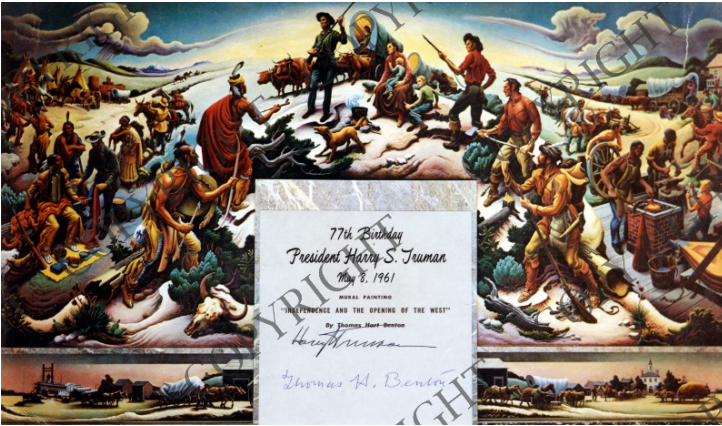


Color lithograph of the Thomas Hart Benton mural "Independence and the Opening of the West," given out at HST's 77th birthday celebration
