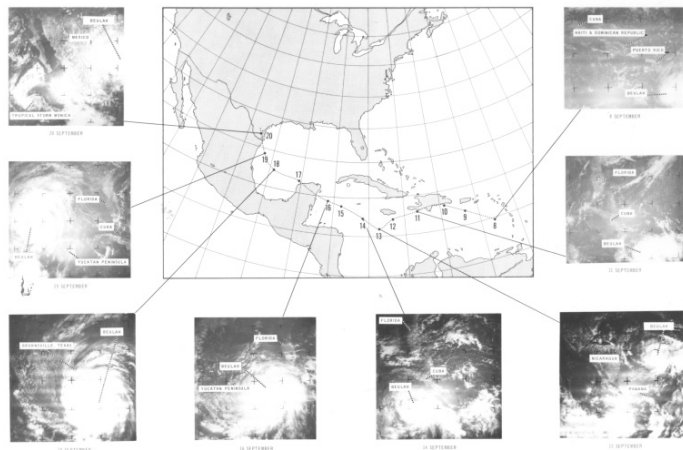


# Satellite Nimbus II tracks Hurricane Beulah

## HURRICANE BEULAH

THE NASA SATELLITE, NIMBUS II, TRACKS DESTRUCTIVE HURRICANE BEULAH ACROSS THE CARIBBEAN SEA, GULF OF MEXICO AND INTO TEXAS FOR TWO WEEKS IN MID-SEPTEMBER 1967. THIS SERIES OF PHOTOGRAPHS IS REPRESENTATIVE OF PICTURES RECEIVED BY APT STATIONS LOCATED IN THE U.S., MEXICO AND CARIBBEAN AREA AS NIMBUS II ORBITED OVER THESE REGIONS DAILY.



## Description

The satellite Nimbus II as it tracks Hurricane Beulah across the Caribbean Sea, Gulf of Mexico and into Texas for two weeks in mid-September 1967. This series of photographs is representative of pictures received by Apt. Stations located in the U.S., Mexico and Caribbean area as Nimbus II orbited over these regions daily.
