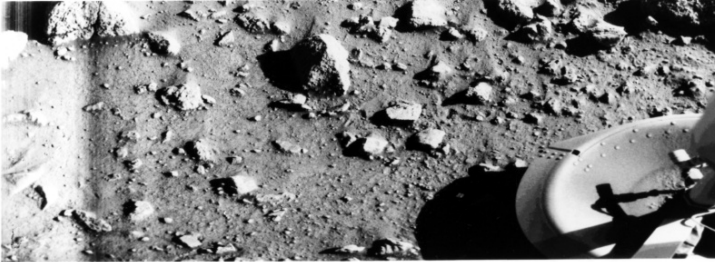


First photograph ever taken of the surface of Mars
