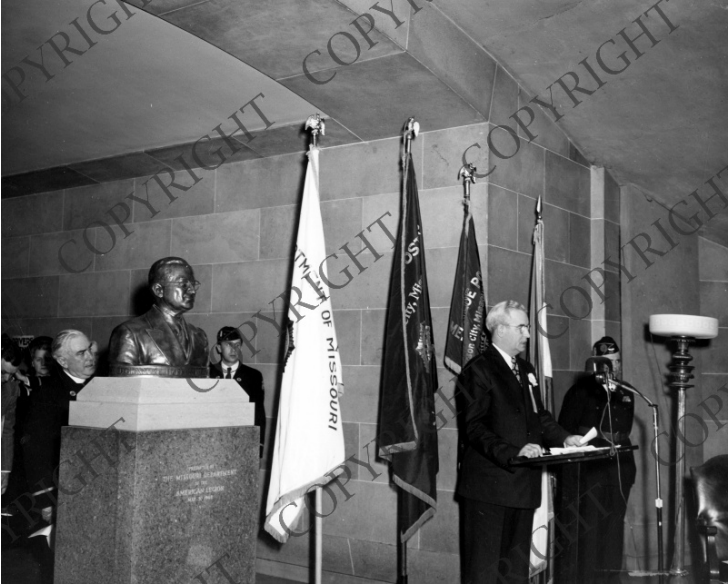


# Ceremony dedicating bust of President Truman
