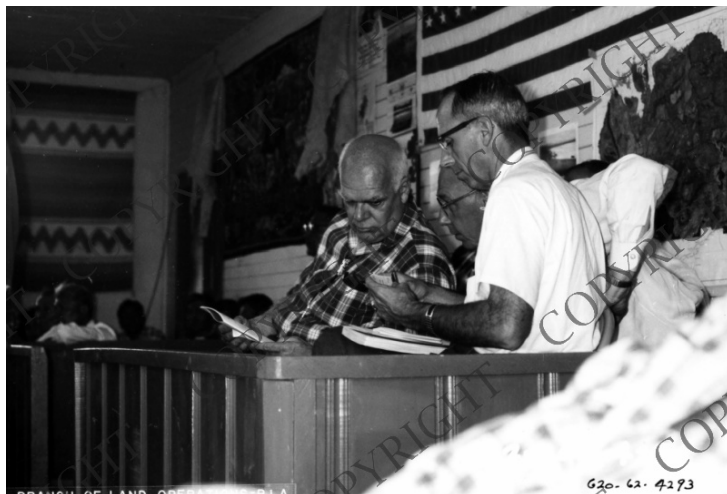


Commissioner of Indian Affairs Philleo Nash During the Klagetoh Meeting
