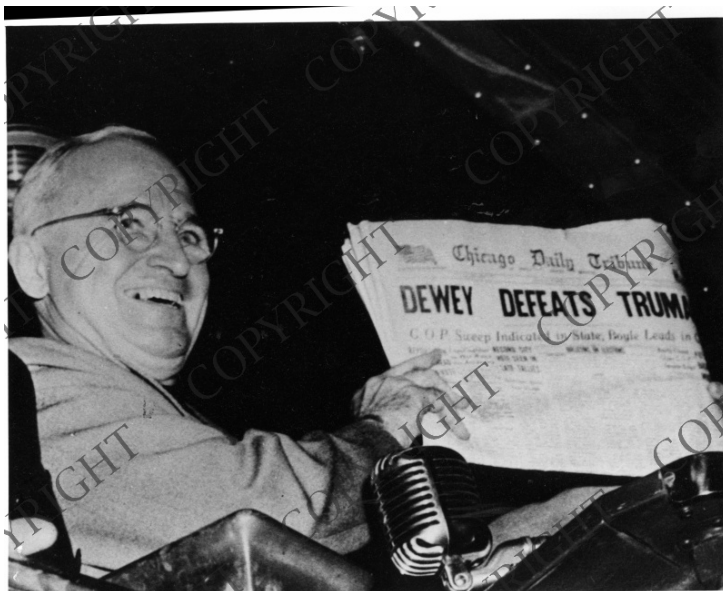


President Harry S. Truman with Chicago Daily Tribune Headline of "Dewey Defeats Truman"
