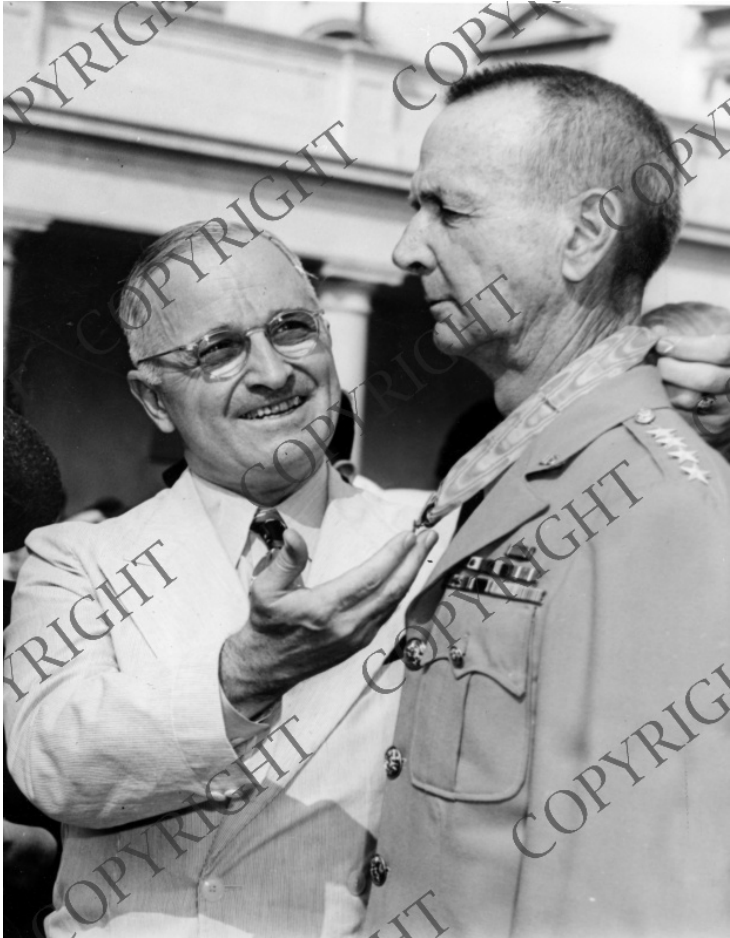


General Jonathan M. Wainwright was presented with the Congressional Medal of Honor by President Truman
