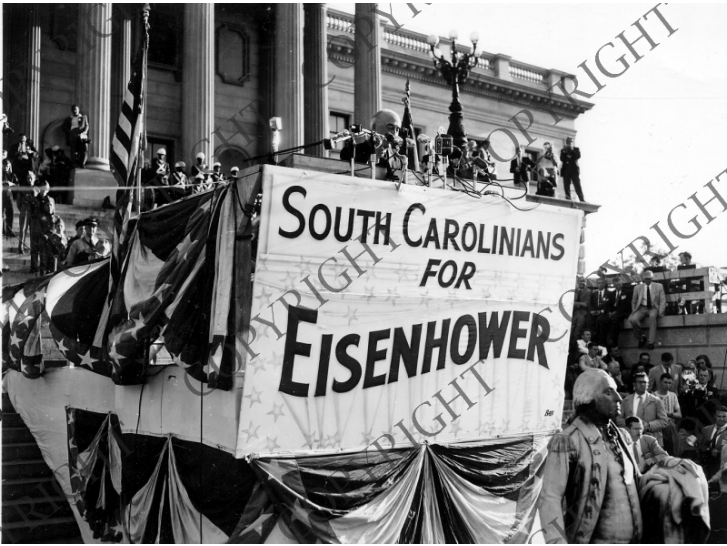


Byrnes Giving Speech
