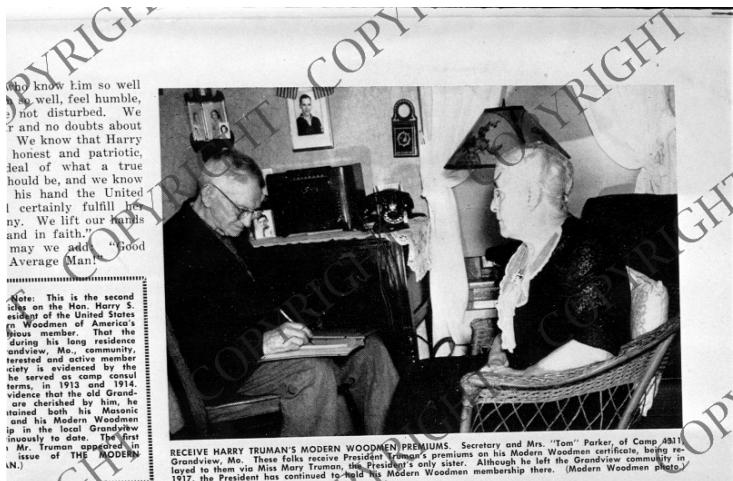


# Mr. and Mrs. Tom Parker
