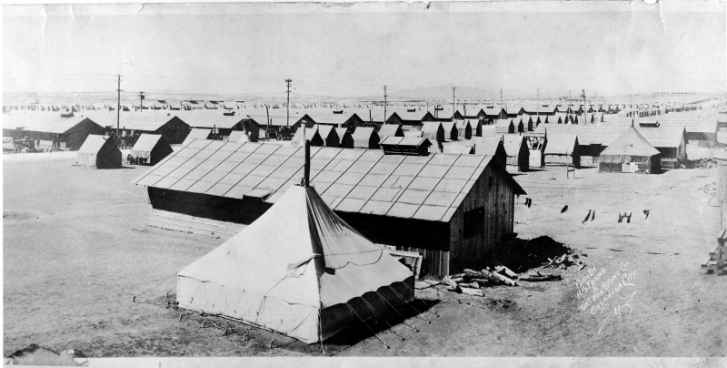


Camp Doniphan, Oklahoma
