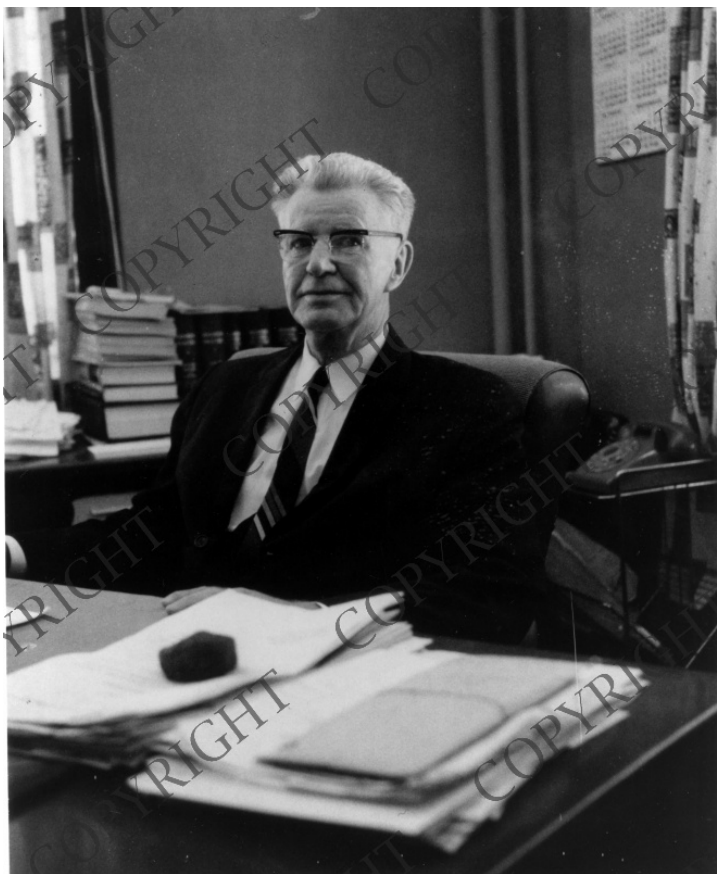


Portrait of Eugene Donnelly
