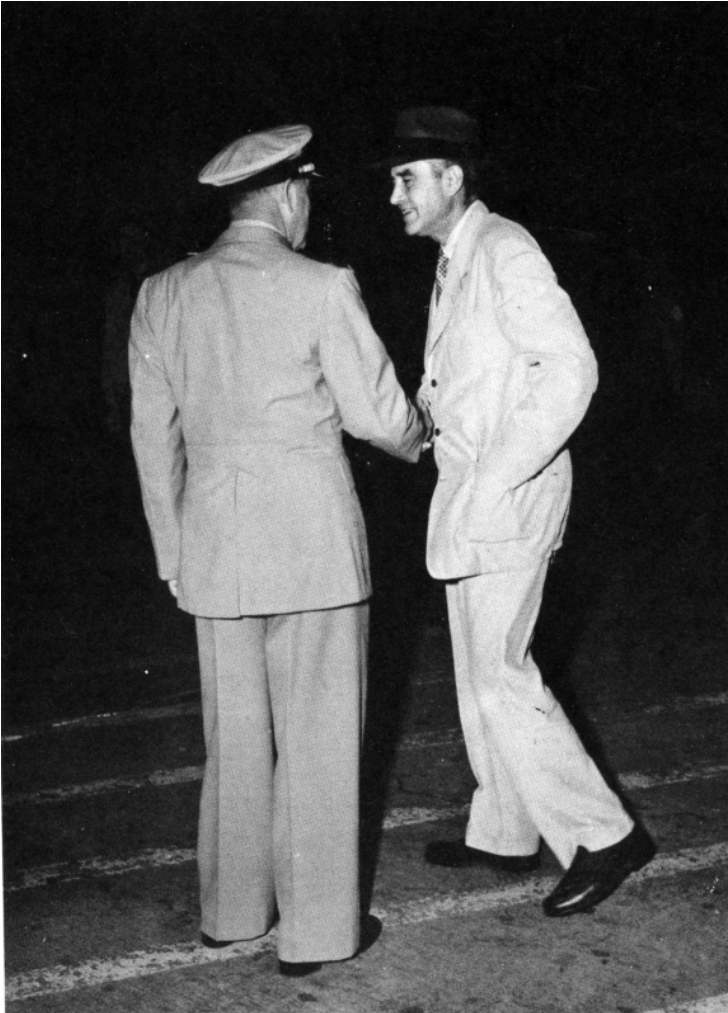


Admiral Arthur W. Radford and W. Averell Harriman at Hickam Air Force Base, Hawaii
