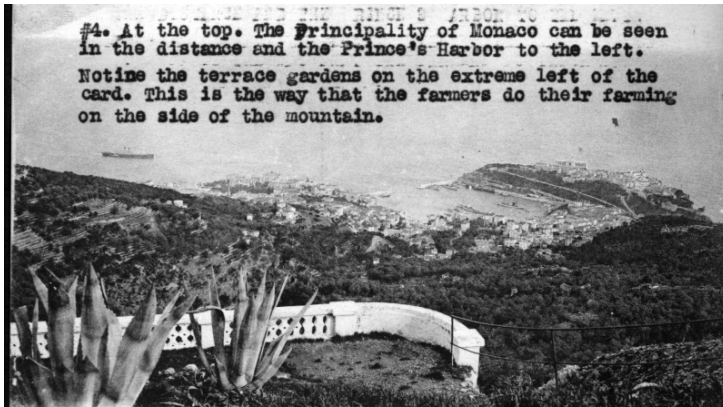


Monaco after World War I
