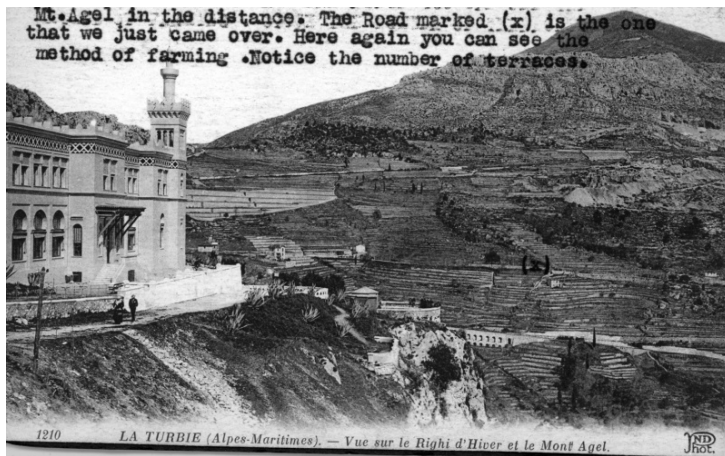


# La Turbie, France after World War I
