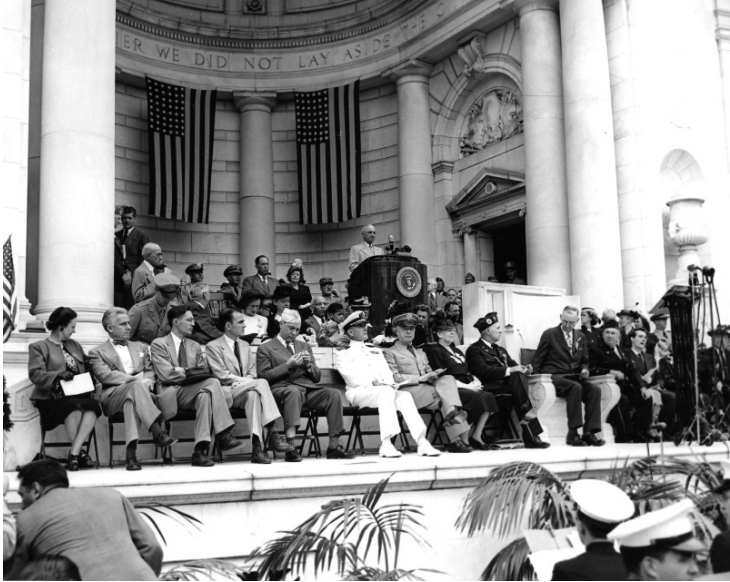


Truman speech at Arlington National Cemetery
