Description

Mine cars stripped for ball and roller bearings, left on their sides outside along railroad track at Peipiao, Manchuria. Mine cars in this condition were observed at all mines visited by the Reparations Mission. Soviet damage at Peipiao consisted primarily of removal of supplies and stocks. Photograph taken during the U.S. Reparations Mission. Edwin Pauley was the U.S. Ambassador on the Allied Reparations Committee from 1945-47 (the committee that assessed the reparations the Axis powers could afford to pay the victors).
