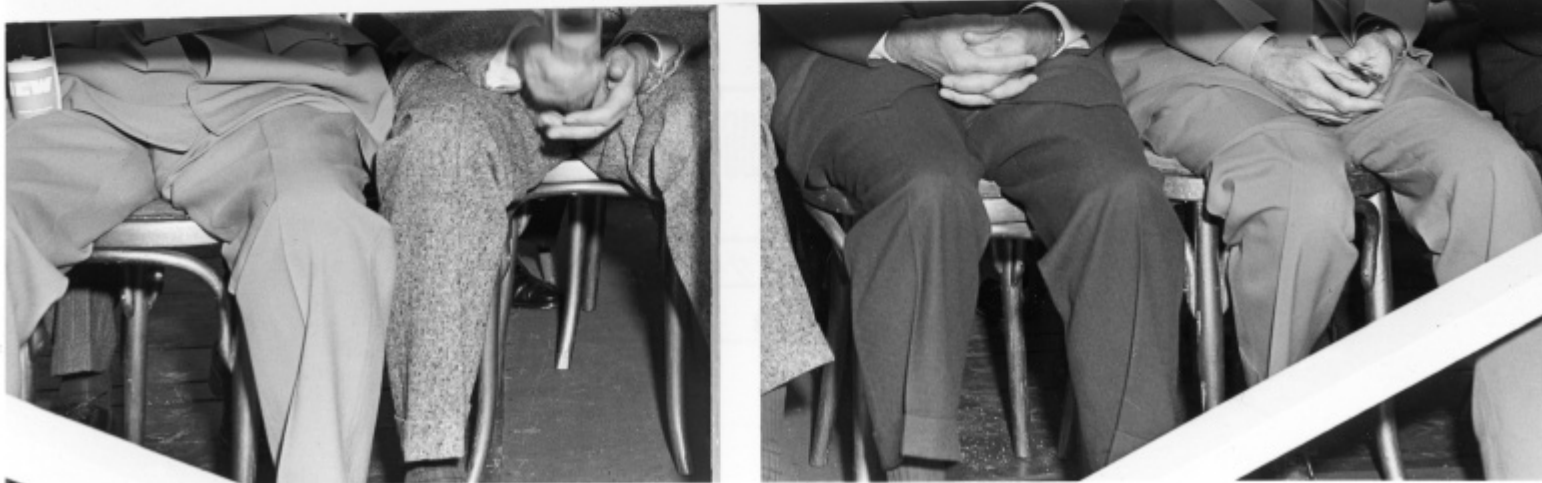


Review Stand of Armed Forces Day Parade
