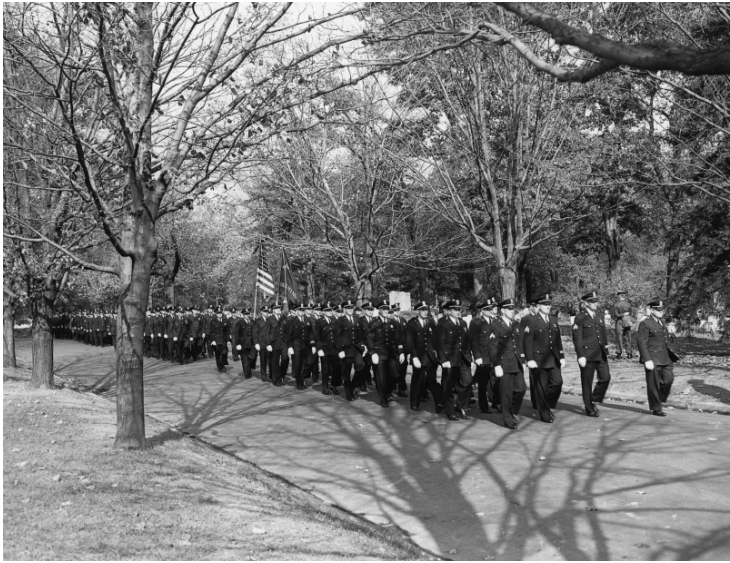


Funeral Services for Leslie Coffelt
