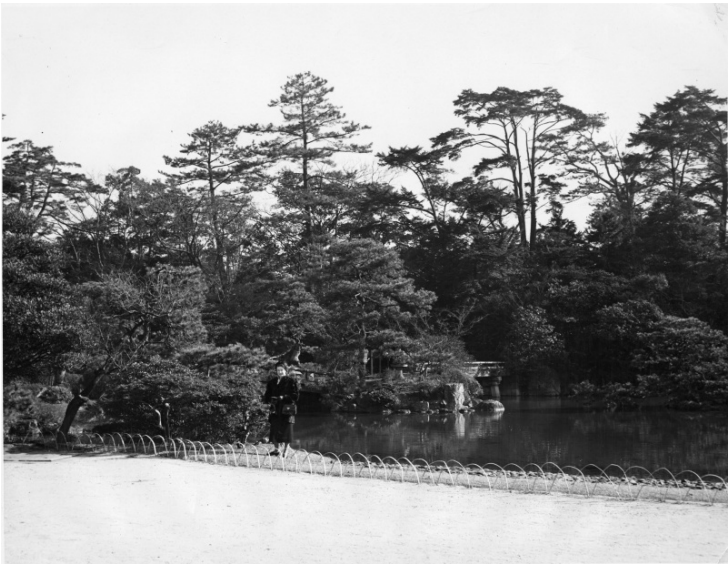


Vernice Anderson in Kyoto
