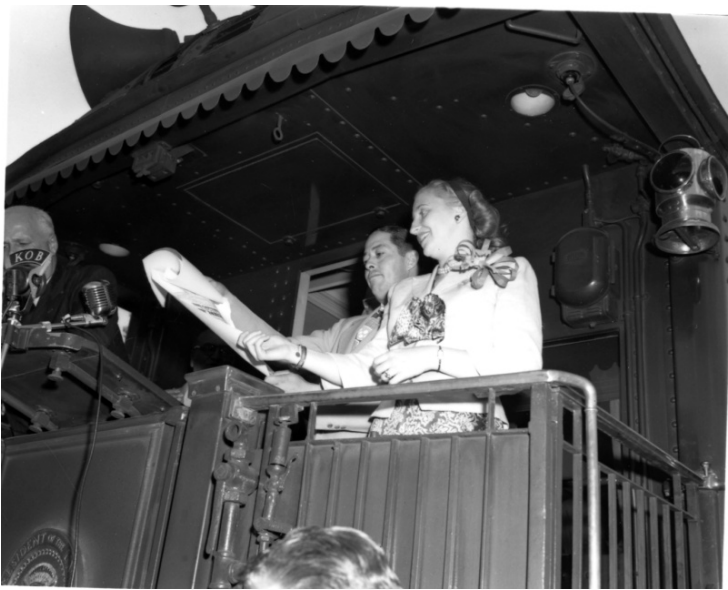


# Margaret Truman and an unidentified man on the back of a train in New Mexico
