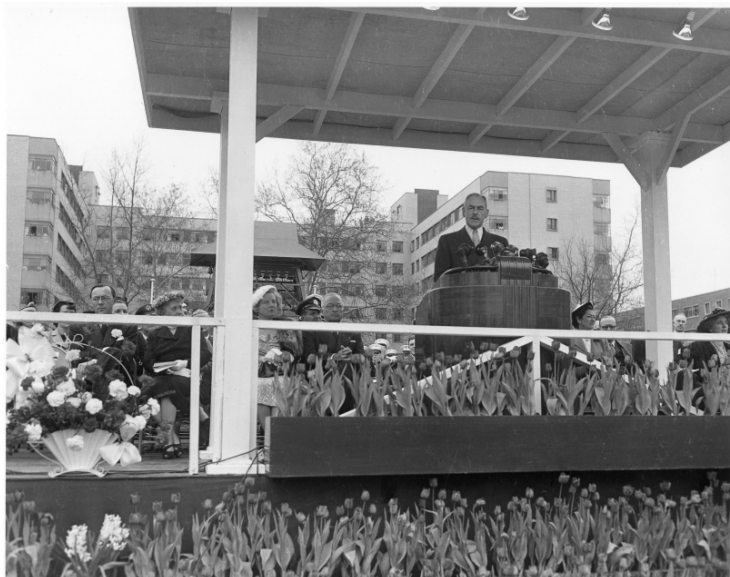


# Secretary Acheson Speaks at Carillon Ceremony
