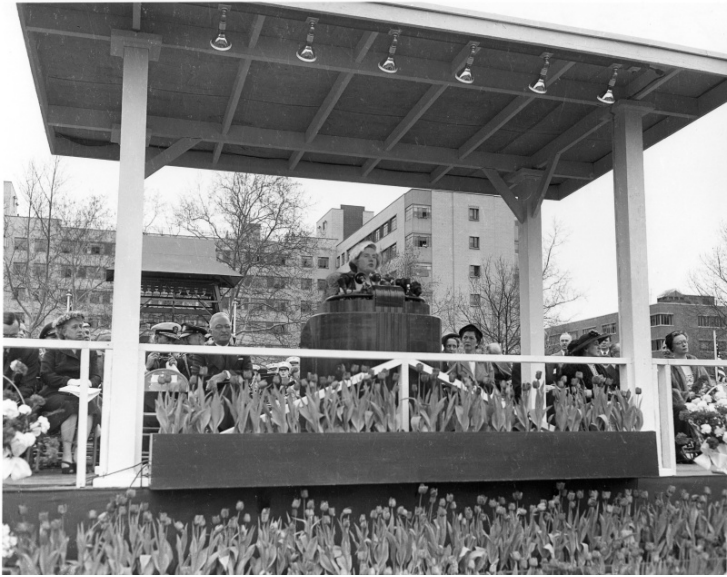


# Queen Juliana Speaking at Carillon Ceremony
