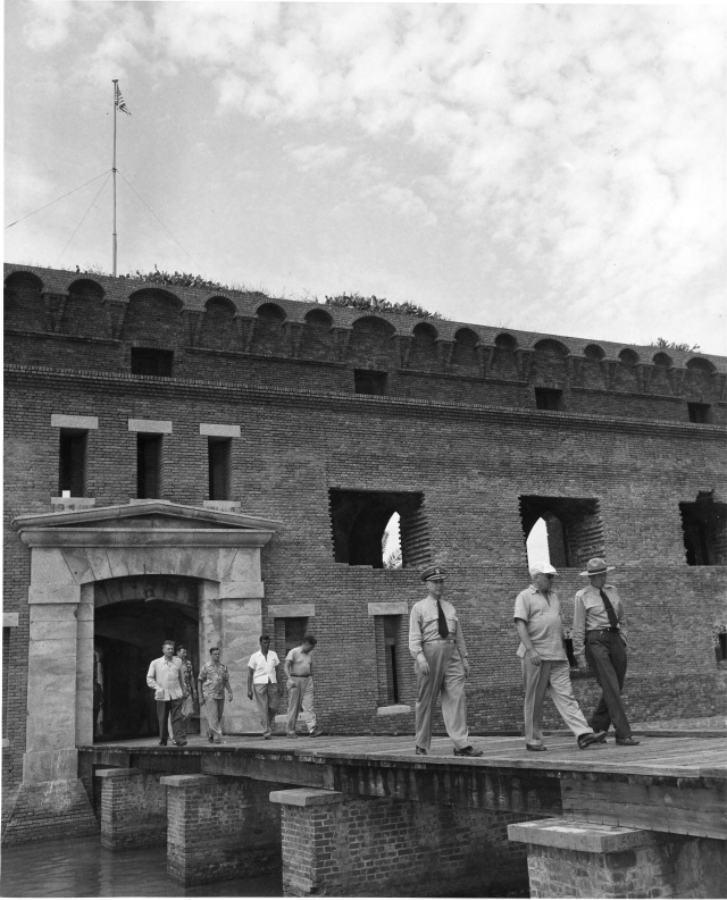


President Truman Leaving Fort Jefferson
