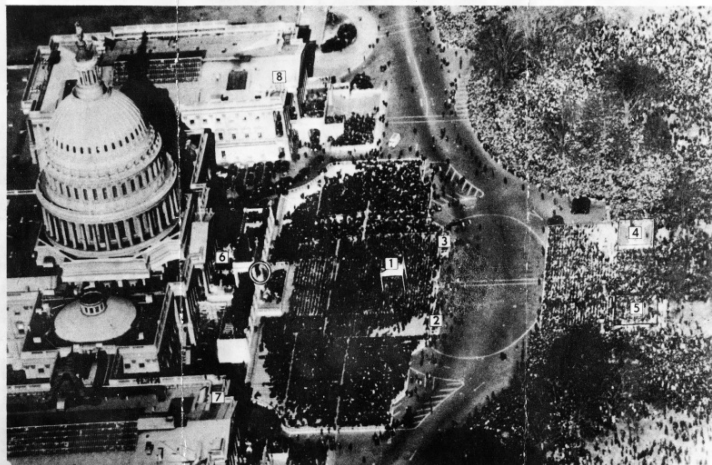


Aerial View of Inauguration Stand Arrangement Plans

Pick Your Spot For The Inauguration



Here's a refresher for the forthcoming presidential inauguration. Plans now call for approximately the same arrangements as at the last grand event. The main stand (No. 1) will be on the level with and about 100 feet from the president (in circle). Stands No. 2 and 3, at the rear of the important guest's seats will be about 130 feet from the president, and below. Two additional ground stands are located at the fountains (No. 4 and 5) about 275 feet away. There will be two small stands at No. 6 for a backshot of the ceremony. Long overhead backshots will be possible from the roofs at No. 7 and No. 8. Tickets also will be issued for positions on the roof of the Senate office building and the dome of the Library of Congress.

Description

This aerial view of the inauguration stand arrangement plans shows the main stand (No. 1) level with and about 100 feet from the president (in circle); stands No. 2 and 3, at the rear of the important guest's seats about 130 feet from the president, and below; two additional grand stands located at the fountains (No. 4 and 5) about 275 feet away; two small stands at No. 6 for a backshot of the ceremony; long overhead backshots from the roofs at No. 7 and 8; and a possibility of additional positions on the roof of the Senate office building and the dome of the Library of Congress.
