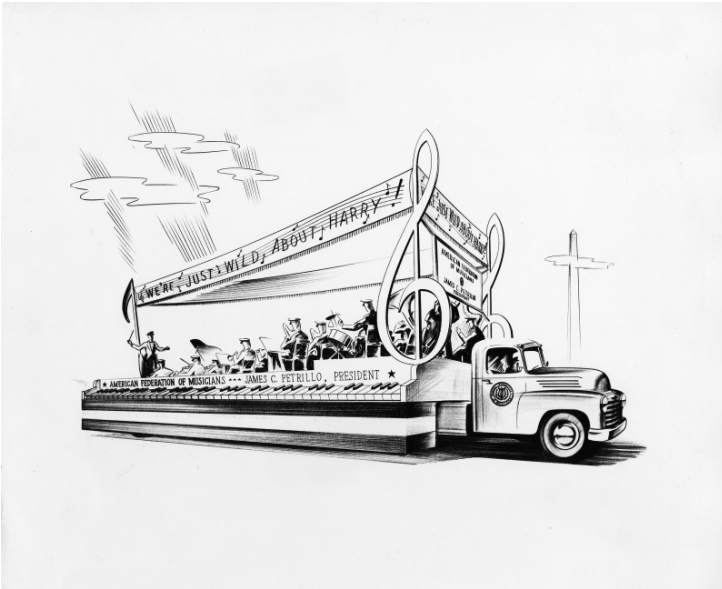


American Federation of Music Inaugural Parade Float Design
