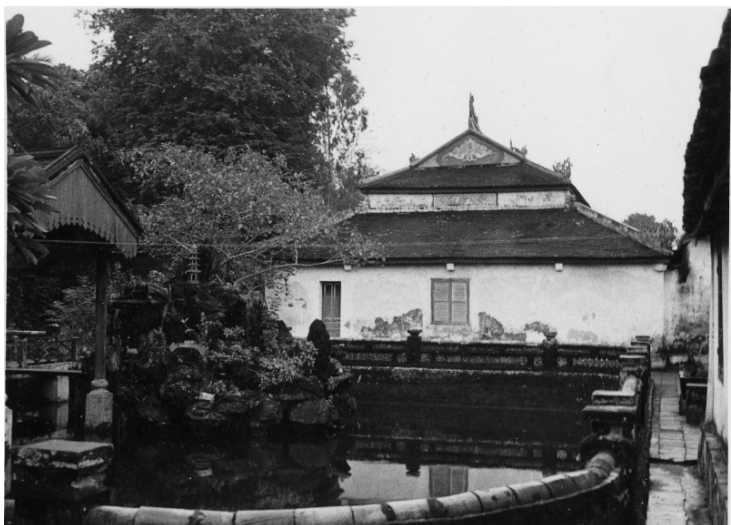


Tu Duc Tomb in Hue, Vietnam
